Money Vigilance


People who identify with this category tend to be savers. They often feel that money needs to be watched, and that **frugality** is **always** best.





Cambridge RISE aims to address the growing economic divide and racial inequities in Cambridge, while also maintaining its diverse population and continuing to be a place families thrive.

Beginning September 2021, Cambridge and its key partners will conduct an 18-month Guaranteed Income Pilot Project for single caretaker households.
