

- 2. Regard for Leadership





Check the Basics

Biblical, Mission Impact(never use the line-item budget), Ask for growth (do the math), Ask for estimate of giving commitment, Be clear and direct, Show and Tell

Plan, Conduct, Follow Up, Thank

Always lead with the vision
